

The Gardens of Remembrance at the crematorium contain many rose beds and, individual roses within them are available for dedication; one plaque is permitted per rose.

Please be aware that if the rose is replanted during the autumn or spring, it will then have an approximate 5 month growth period (spring - autumn) after planting. This means that the rose has not had enough time to mature and it will be the following summer that you will see an improvement with both flower and foliage.

The Terms and Conditions that apply are:-

1. The initial lease period is for 10 years from the date of placing the memorial plaque in the grounds. The lease can continue to be renewed by lease periods in existence at the time of expiry.
2. Only the leaseholder can apply for an extension on the lease or any changes to the plaque.
3. At the end of the lease, the leaseholder will be contacted at the last given address. If the leaseholder changes address it is their responsibility to inform the Bereavement Services office.
4. If the lease is not renewed, the plaque will be removed from the grounds and retained for 3 months in the Bereavement Services office, from where it can be collected if required.
5. The wording on the plaque is restricted to a maximum of 19 characters per line with 3 lines for a single plaque, 5 lines for a double plaque and 7 lines for a triple plaque.
6. The council reserves the right to refuse any wording that is considered unsuitable.
7. The final layout of the inscription is at the discretion of the engraver.
8. Once placed in the grounds, the plaque becomes the property and responsibility of the leaseholder. The rose remains the property of the council and the leaseholder has no rights regarding it.
9. The council has a right to replace roses for any reason.
10. Arrangements can be made to scatter ashes on the grass near to the rose, but not on the rose itself. The applicant for a cremation must make this request. Please note the grounds are communal in nature and other remains may be strewn in the same vicinity.
11. No vases, pot plants, shrubs, bedding plants or any other form of tribute are permitted in the grounds.
12. Leaseholders will be notified when the plaque is in position.
13. Replacement plaques commemorating 2 or 3 persons are available for a fee. The lease will be from the placement of the original plaque.
